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NOTICES

1. ANNOUNCEMENTS:

To avoid making costly errors, please pay close attention to all announcements made from the auction stand, especially concerning horses on which you intend to bid.

2. ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF PURCHASE:

After making the final bid on a horse, you will be asked to complete and sign the Acknowledgement of Purchase Form. Be sure to confirm the correct Hip Number and price before you sign. Please print your name and address (including Postal Code/Zip Code) clearly, since this document is used for Jockey Club Certificate Transfers, invoicing and in publishing the sales results.

3. CARE OF HORSES:

Please be reminded that the title passes at the fall of the hammer, at which time the purchaser assumes all risk and responsibility for the horse. **ALL HORSES MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE SALE PREMISES NO LATER THAN 24 HOURS FROM THE FALL OF THE HAMMER.**

Buyers should notify both the consignor and the sales office when they intend to move horses after the sale.

4. STABLE RELEASE:

In order to remove a horse from the grounds, you must obtain a Stable Release form from the sales office. Please confirm that the release you obtain represents the correct hip number. Also be sure to give the release to the person ultimately responsible for removing your horse from the grounds.

5. COGGINS TESTS & VACCINATIONS:

All horses sold in this sale are required to have been tested Coggins Negative within 6 months of the date of sale as well as vaccinated for Flu and Rhino in the current year.

6. TRANSFER & REPORT OF OWNERSHIP:

The transfer of ownership for all Thoroughbreds must be reported to the Jockey Club by the new owner, within 60 days of the transfer, using a Transfer of Ownership form. The Certificate of Registration is not required and there is no fee for any transfer. Forms are available in Sales Office.

7. EVA:

Horses in the sale are not required to be pre-sale tested for EVA. There is no post-sale of return to EVA unless offered specifically and individually by the consignor through the sales company. A list of those that pre-sale tested will be available at the sales office.

8. STAKES ENGAGEMENTS:

Unless announced otherwise all eligibility payments due after date of sale are the responsibility of the buyer, who should promptly notify the proper racing associations of the new ownership in order to receive direct billing.

DEFINITIONS

Registered Canadian-Bred

Thoroughbreds foaled in Canada and have been registered as such with the Canadian Thoroughbred Horse Society, National Office.

Registered Ontario-Bred

A foal that is Registered Canadian-Bred and is foaled out of an Ontario Resident mare. Ontario Resident Mare status is determined by the rules set out by the Ontario Horse Improvement Program administrators.

Ontario-Sired

In order for horses to be recognized as Ontario-Sired the only requirement is that they be by stallions that were nominated to the Ontario Sires Stakes Program, through the Canadian Thoroughbred Horse Society (Ontario Division), in the year the mare is bred.

POST SALE RNA PROGRAM

The CTHS will be giving buyers, that have established credit, an opportunity to bid on horses that were not sold (RNA) at sales time.

Interested purchasers can simply go to the Sales Results page and click on Submit a Bid for the horse(s) they are interested in purchasing. This will send an email to both the consignor and the CTHS advising them of their interest.

It will then be left up to the consignor and the purchaser to negotiate. If a post sale agreement is finalized the parties must move forward through the CTHS Sales Office.

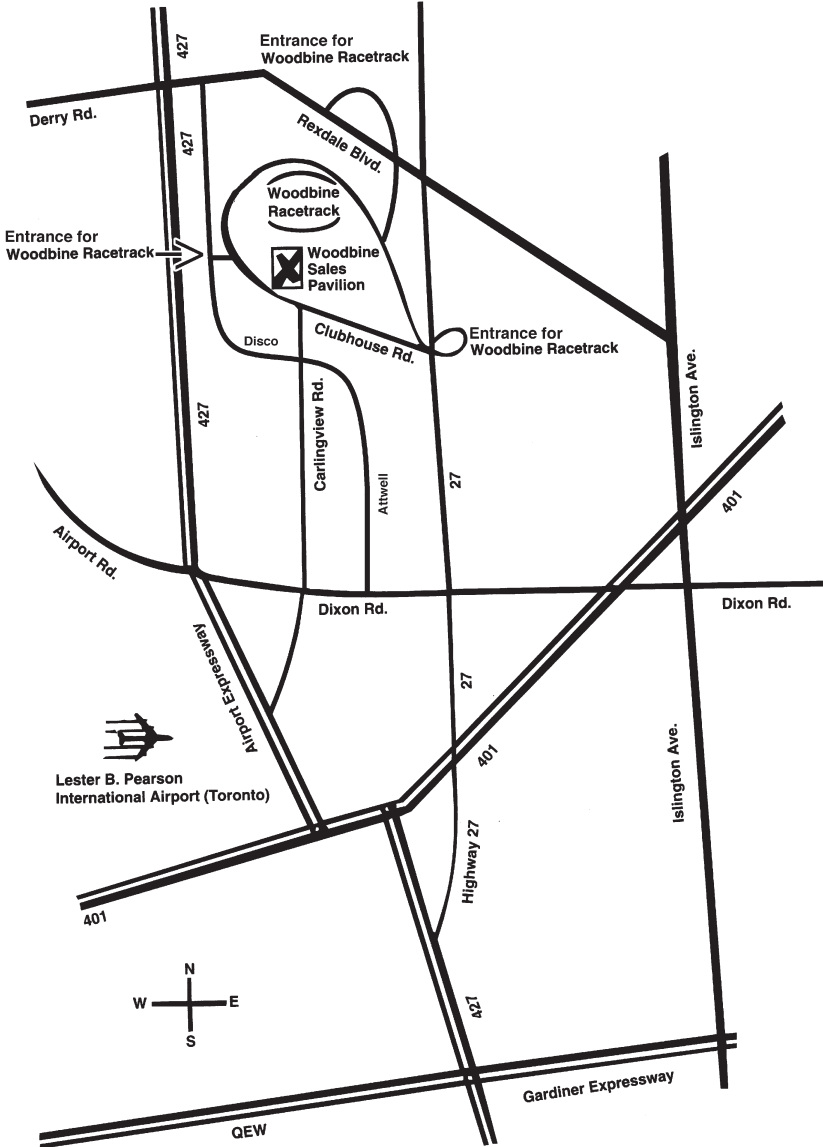

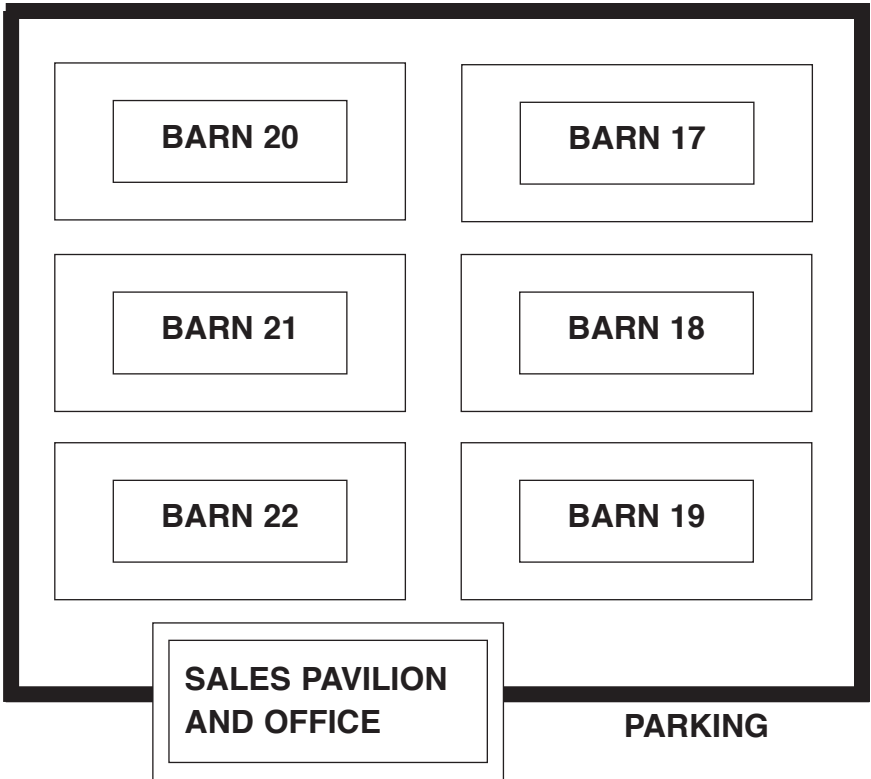
WOODBINE MAP

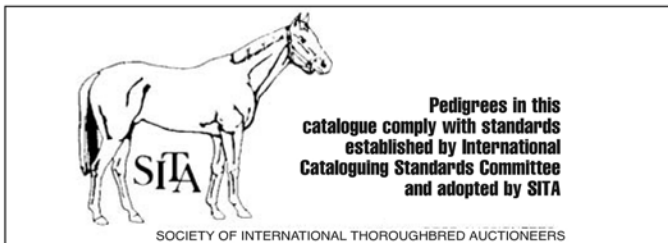

CANADIAN SALES STAKES SERIES



Commencing in 2018, all Canadian-Bred Yearling Graduates of CTHS Provincial Sales, that have met the eligibility requirements within their respective Provinces, will now be eligible to run in Sales Stakes offered across the country in 2019.

Provincial Sales Stakes Eligibility, Sale Dates & Sales Stakes Races Offered:

Yearlings must meet Sales Stakes eligibility requirements in the Province in which they ran through a CTHS sanctioned yearling sale. In addition, if required the yearling must continue to meet eligibility requirements in the Province in which they sold. The current eligibility requirements by Province are as follows:

BRITISH COLUMBIA: a yearling is eligible for the Sales Stakes series that passes through the BC sale where the full commission and nomination fee is paid to the CTHS and an annual nomination amount is paid to remain eligible. The Canadian Sales Stakes series is only open to Canadian-Breds.

Canadian Sales Stakes Series Eligibility:

Once all the Provincial Sales Stakes Eligibility has been met the following conditions apply:

- 1. Out-of-Province Nominations** – Nomination to an out of Province sales stake (not in the Province where the yearling sold) will be the responsibility of the owners who will pay \$750 to nominate, \$750 to enter and \$1,000 to start. Note that in Ontario the difference between the listed nomination, entry and starting fee charged by WEG and the nomination, entry and starting fees charged per the above will be paid directly to the CTHS Ontario at the time of nomination. In addition, in the event that races are over subscribed, preference will be given to horses that passed through the sale in the jurisdiction in which the Sales Stake is being held. For example, CTHS Ontario sales graduates will have preference for the Sales Stakes races in Ontario
- 2. Implementation** – Canadian bred yearlings passing through the CTHS Yearling sales in 2018 that meet the eligibility requirements above will be eligible Canadian Sales Stakes Series. The inclusion of Ontario in 2018 does not affect the eligibility of Sales Graduates from previous years who will remain eligible for the Western Canadian Sales Stakes Series. For clarity, Sales graduates from previous years who are eligible for the Western Sales Stakes Series are not eligible for the Sales Stakes in Ontario.
- 3. Sales Stakes Dates** – Where possible, the CTHS Provincial offices will work collaboratively to attempt to schedule the Sales Stakes in each Province so that we can eventually create a series that allows owners to participate in the sales stakes in multiple Provinces.

Note: *Canadian Sales Stakes Series Eligibility is determined by an agreement between all Provincial CTHS Boards and is subject to change at their discretion.*

BLACK TYPE DEFINITIONS

Black Type Race-Black Type Winner-Black Type Placed

The words “black-type” are the equivalent, in racing, sales terminology and in sales catalogues, of the frequently-used word “stakes.” A stakes race will not always merit “black” type in a sales catalogue.

Black Type Race or Stakes Race

There are several classes of black type races, which are described in the following information. A black type race must, by definition, close for entries at least 72 hours before it is run. Fees must also be paid towards the purse by owners and/or additional (added) money contributed by or through the host racetrack. In addition, a stakes race must have a total purse value distributed on the day of the race of \$50,000 or more. (This minimum was established in January 2007 and is frequently reviewed.) In the more liberal interpretation of “stakes,” the amount of the purse is not always a factor, but a race qualifies for “black type” in sales catalogue following ICSC (International Cataloguing Standards Committee) standards only when it meets the total purse and other criteria.

In pedigrees, a horse’s name, when it is a winner or has placed in a black type race, is indicated in bold (hence “black”) type. Winners’ names are in upper case (capital) bold letters. Horses placing 2nd or 3rd are in lower case bold letters.

In addition, further symbols or designators associated with the black type race will indicate the level or quality of the race in question.

It is important to note that changes in entry requirements, restrictions and purse levels for black type races are not retrospective. Once awarded black type in a pedigree, this information is unchanged and permanently maintained until and unless it is required to be replaced by more current data.

Graded or Group Black Type Races

All around the world “graded” or “group” stakes race (G1, G2 and G3) is recognized as being of the highest quality within any racing jurisdiction. The words “grade” and “group” have identical meaning and qualifications.

The Society of International Thoroughbred Auctioneers (SITA), CTHS (Ontario-Division), uses the rulings of the International Cataloguing Standards Committee (ICSC) in its sales pedigrees to recognize grade or group designators for races.

ICSC maintains and monitors the application of guidelines by racing countries around the world. These countries qualify for several categories for cataloguing purposes as follows:

Part I countries will receive black type status and any race designators including grade/group indicators that are applicable.

Part II countries receive black type status, but will not be eligible to carry any designators such as grade/group indicators.

Part III countries have races listed for informational purposes only and do not receive any black type status.

In the USA, graded races are classified by the American-Graded Stakes Committee of the Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders' Association (TOBA). This committee meets regularly to insure its standards of purse money and quality of racing are maintained.

Graded races are non-restricted, (age and sex qualifications are not considered restrictions.) From January 2003, the minimum value for a graded race has been \$100,000.

Listed Black Type Races (L)

Below the quality of graded races, listed races also have a minimum added and/or total purse value, which, in January 2002, was set at \$75,000. For this and for other considerations, they do not qualify as graded black type races.

The name of the listed black-type race is detailed after the subject horse in the pedigree with the designator (L), and, in parentheses, an abbreviation of the host track and the purse earned specifically in that race. Up to the end of December 1990, some listed races were also restricted races and carried the designator (LR). Since that time, listed races may not be restricted.

Restricted Races

Because entry conditions for restricted races are often framed to exclude better horses, these black type races are usually regarded as of lesser quality than graded or listed races. The name of the restricted black type race is detailed after the subject horse in the pedigree with the designator ® and, in parentheses, an abbreviation of the host track and the purse earned specifically in that race.

From January 2003, conditions for black type restricted races were refined and the only restrictions now allowed are those for state-bred runners, non-winners of a sweepstakes, sales graduates and stallions' progeny.

Other Races Identified in Catalogues

There are some black type races which are not restricted, but do not have sufficient purse money to qualify as listed races. These races are identified by name but carry NO designator (G, L or R). The name of the race is detailed after the subject horse and, in parentheses, an abbreviation of the host track and the purse earned specifically in that race.

The amount of purse money to qualify a race for black type status is regularly raised by SITA to insure the quality and integrity of the black type system.

Further Note

In 1985, several other stakes qualified for black type or for inclusion in some form in pedigrees. Subsequent changes have replaced or eliminated these races, but they remain in pedigrees until they are excluded by more current data. Such races carried designators (O), (N) and (Q).

Pedigrees in this catalogue comply with standards established by the International Cataloguing Standards Committee (ICSC) and adopted by the Society of International Thoroughbred Auctioneers (SITA).

Any yearling sold after July 1st of its yearling year, two-year-old in training or horse of racing age that has any one of the following defects of wind must be so announced at the time of sale: (i) Laryngeal hemiplegia (complete immobility or inability to fully abduct the cartilage); (ii) Rostral displacement of the palatopharyngeal arch; (iii) Epiglottic entrapment; (iv) Permanent dorsal displacement of the soft palate; (v) Severe arytenoid chondritis or arytenoid chondroma(s); (vi) Subepiglottic cyst or cysts; or (vii) Cleft palate. In addition, any horse sold in a two-year-old in training sale or horse of racing age sale which has injury to or disease of the bone structure materially affecting its suitability for racing must be announced as having such condition at the time of its sale, or, as to any such horse sold in a two-year-old in training sale, such condition must be revealed by radiographs placed in the Repository by the Consignor.

SIXTH – CATALOGUE AND ANNOUNCEMENTS: Horses catalogued in this sale are offered with information as represented by Consignor. The accuracy of such information is the responsibility of Consignor and not Auctioneer. While certain information may have been procured by Auctioneer from third parties on behalf of Consignor, it remains solely the responsibility of Consignor to verify the accuracy of such information and to notify Auctioneer of any corrections. With respect to produce records of broodmares the term 'not pregnant' shall be construed to mean that the mare was bred, was not found to have slipped, and failed to produce a foal. So that an appropriate announcement can be made prior to sale, notices of corrections must be delivered in writing to Auctioneer at its sales office not less than thirty (30) minutes prior to sale. IN CASE OF ANY ERROR OR OMISSION, BUYER SHALL SEEK REDRESS ONLY FROM CONSIGNOR.

SEVENTH – BIDDING PROCEDURE: Unless waived by Announcement, there shall be an upset price on any horse offered as set forth on the title page of the sales catalogue. If an opening bid of the upset price is not immediately forthcoming to the auctioneer's call, the horse shall be led out unsold. Minimum acceptable increases in bidding are: \$100 until the bid reaches \$25,000 and \$500 thereafter. The person making the highest bid recognized by auctioneer shall be the Buyer. Auctioneer shall immediately present Buyer with a document entitled Acknowledgement of Purchase for Buyer's signature. Should such presentation not be made prior to commencement of bidding on the next lot offered, Buyer shall forthwith identify himself or herself to Auctioneer as the Buyer and sign the Acknowledgement of Purchase. In the event that a person other than the recognized Buyer signs the Acknowledgement of Purchase, such action shall not give such other person any right or title to the horse. Immediately upon such erroneous signing of an Acknowledgement of Purchase becoming known to Auctioneer, an Acknowledgement of Purchase shall be presented to the recognized Buyer for signature.

EIGHTH – BIDDING DISPUTES: Should any dispute arise between or among two or more bidders, Auctioneer shall forthwith adjudicate the dispute, and Auctioneer's decision shall be absolute, final and binding on all parties. Bids tendered after fall of the hammer are not valid grounds for dispute. Bids received by personnel employed by Auctioneer have the same stature as bids received by the auctioneer in the stand. In case of dispute, the bidding shall be reopened for advance bids, and if there be no advance bid, the horse is sold to the person from whom Auctioneer recognized the last bid. Advance bidding shall be restricted to the disputing parties, unless the bid be reduced below the level of the recognized bid at commencement of the dispute, in which case bidding is reopened to all. Auctioneer reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

NINTH – TITLE AND DELIVERY: Title passes to Buyer at the fall of the hammer, at which time all risk and responsibility pertaining to the horse passes to Buyer. The horse will be held for Buyer by Consignor until Buyer makes settlement as provided in CONDITION TENTH, and Auctioneer shall have no responsibility whatsoever with respect to the horse. Buyer shall immediately present himself to make settlement upon fall of the hammer. Upon settlement by Buyer, the horse will be delivered by issuance of a “stable release” to Buyer or Buyer’s designee authorizing removal of the horse from the sales premises, but in any case taking possession of the horse by Buyer or Buyer’s representative shall constitute delivery and acceptance. Buyer shall cause the horse to be removed promptly from the sales premises, or be subject to stable charges determined by Auctioneer. In addition, should Buyer fail to cause the horse to be removed promptly, Auctioneer may cause the horse to be removed and then stabled at Buyer’s risk and expense.

TENTH – CREDIT AND SETTLEMENT: Buyer shall make settlement with Auctioneer immediately upon fall of hammer, unless credit shall have been extended in advance by Auctioneer to Buyer. If Buyer’s account is not paid in full within fifteen days of sale, Buyer shall pay to Auctioneer a service charge of 2 per cent per month and the unpaid balance of the account from the date of sale until paid. Payments to others, including the Consignors or their representatives, do not constitute settlement. Buyer shall make settlement as provided above for the full purchase price and applicable sales tax, in Canadian currency or bank cheque, certified cheque or equivalent acceptable to auctioneer. BIDDERS ARE CAUTIONED THAT EXTENSION OF CREDIT AT A PRIOR SALE DOES NOT ESTABLISH CREDIT AT THIS SALE. BIDDERS MUST CLEAR OUTSTANDING ACCOUNTS AND ESTABLISH CREDIT AT THIS SALE PRIOR TO BIDDING. Bidders and other persons signing for or buying on behalf of or in the name of a corporation, partnership, trust or other entity – including purchases through an authorized agent agree to be personally responsible for payment of all sums owed to Auctioneer. Buyer grants to Auctioneer a security interest in each horse purchase, its Jockey Club Certificate of Foal Registration, any applicable stallion service certificate, and any proceeds or products thereof, to secure payment of the amount of unpaid purchase price, sales tax, and other indebtedness owed by Buyer to Auctioneer or Auctioneer’s affiliates. Buyer appoints Auctioneer as buyer’s attorney-in-fact to prepare, execute and file any Financing Statements or other documents necessary to perfect, enforce and give notice of the security interest created herein. Buyer agrees that Auctioneer shall have all rights and remedies of a Secured Party pursuant to the Conditions of Sale and the Uniform Commercial Code or other applicable law.

ELEVENTH – DEFAULTERS: SHOULD BUYER FAIL TO COMPLY IN ANY RESPECT WITH CONDITIONS NINTH AND TENTH ABOVE, AUCTIONEER MAY, IN ITS ABSOLUTE DISCRETION, PURSUE ANY REMEDY AVAILABLE TO IT AGAINST THE DEFAULTING BUYER, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, TAKING POSSESSION OF THE HORSE OR RESELLING OF THE HORSE AT PUBLIC AUCTION OR BY PRIVATE TREATY FOR ACCOUNT OF DEFAULTER. In any case, Buyer shall be liable for any deficiency after charging to Buyer’s account all costs of maintenance and resale, including, but not limited to, service charges, attorney’s fees, costs of litigation, and damages available at law to Auctioneer.

TWELFTH – RIGHT OF RETURN: Any horse sold in this sale which has a condition that must be announced as provided for in CONDITIONS FOURTH and FIFTH, and is not so announced, shall be subject to return to Consignor, with refund of purchase price if already paid, PROVIDED THAT WITHIN FORTH-EIGHT (48) HOURS AFTER TIME OF SALE THE AUCTIONEER RECEIVES WRITTEN NOTICE FROM THE BUYER AND A WRITTEN VETERINARY CERTIFICATE, BASED ON EXAMINATION BY THE CERTIFYING VETERINARIAN, STATING THAT SUCH A CONDITION EXISTS, AND THE SAME EXISTED AT TIME OF SALE. AS TO ANY HORSE SOLD AS A TWO-YEAR-OLD IN TRAINING, THE VETERINARY CERTIFICATE MUST ALSO STATE THAT THE INJURY TO OR DISEASE OF THE BONE STRUCTURE MATERIALLY AFFECTS THE HORSE’S SUITABILITY FOR RACING AND SUCH CONDITION WAS NOT REVEALED BY RADIOGRAPHS PLACED IN THE REPOSITORY BY THE CONSIGNOR. ALL WARRANTIES TERMINATE UPON THE EARLIER OF (1) EXPIRATION OF FORTY-EIGHT (48) HOURS FROM TIME OF SALE, OR (2) REMOVAL OF THE HORSE FROM SALES GROUNDS, AFTER WHICH THERE SHALL BE NO RIGHT OF RETURN HEREUNDER; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, BUYER SHALL HAVE FIFTEEN DAYS FROM THE TIME OF SALE TO PROVIDE AUCTIONEER WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF HORSES ON AN OFFICIAL

“BLEEDER’S LIST.” Any horse sold in this sale which is determined to have been offered for sale in violation of conditions contained herein, shall be subject to return to the Consignor with a refund of the purchase price if already paid, PROVIDED THAT BUYER, UPON NOTIFICATION BY THE SALES COMPANY OF THE RIGHT OF RETURN PURSUANT TO CONDITIONS CONTAINED HEREIN, NOTIFIES THE SALES COMPANY IN WRITING, OF BUYER’S EXERCISE OF THIS RIGHT WITHIN FIFTEEN (15) DAYS FROM THE TIME OF SALE OF THE HORSE. NOTWITHSTANDING THE FOREGOING, ALL WARRANTIES AND RIGHTS OF RETURN ON A HORSE OF RACING AGE TERMINATE IMMEDIATELY WHEN SUCH HORSE STARTS IN A RACE. Further, any use after this sale of any horse two (2) years of age (as that term is defined by the Jockey Club) or older “under tack,” after discovery of any condition of such horse which would permit its return as provided herein, shall void all right of return and terminate any warranties which might otherwise exist. The rights of Buyer to return the horse as provided herein to the Consignor shall be Buyer’s sole and exclusive remedy. ANY RIGHT OF RETURN AS SET FORTH IN THIS CONDITION TWELFTH IS CONTINGENT UPON THE HORSE BEING IN MATERIALLY THE SAME CONDITION AS IT WAS AT THE TIME OF SALE. UPON THE DETERMINATION BY THE SALES COMPANY THAT A BUYER’S CLAIM TO A RIGHT OF RETURN IS VALID, THE SALES COMPANY SHALL NOTIFY THE CONSIGNOR OF THE RETURN AND UPON RECEIPT OF SUCH NOTICE, ALL RISKS OF LOSS, INJURY, SICKNESS, DISEASE AND ANY AND ALL OTHER RISKS PERTAINING TO THE HORSE PASS TO CONSIGNOR AND/OR OWNER. Upon return of a horse to Consignor in accordance with these Conditions of Sale, Consignor shall be responsible for reasonable expenses for keep, maintenance and transportation of the horse from the time of sale until return.

THIRTEENTH – RESOLUTION OF DISPUTES: (a) ANY CONTROVERSY ARISING OUT OF A CLAIM MADE BY OR ON BEHALF OF BUYER UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF CONDITIONS CONTAINED HEREIN SHALL BE SETTLED BY VETERINARY ARBITRATION BETWEEN BUYER AND CONSIGNOR PURSUANT TO THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURE: Upon Auctioneer’s determination that a claim under such Conditions of Sale has been timely and properly presented, Auctioneer shall notify a panel of three veterinarians, specializing in equine medicine, created specifically to evaluate the validity of disputes arising from warranties or medication policy compliance in Conditions of Sale. This panel shall conduct any tests, investigations or examinations which it deems necessary and, except as requested by the panel, buyer and Consignor shall not be heard, present evidence or cross-examine witnesses, same being waived by all parties. Based upon its review, the panel shall, by majority vote, determine the validity of the claim and whether to uphold or rescind the sale. The decision of the veterinary panel shall be final and binding on all interested parties and shall not be subject to any further review. All expenses incurred by the panel shall be reimbursed by the party whose property the panel determines the horse to be.

FOURTEENTH –

Limited Warranties: Consignor warrants that any weanling or yearling entered in this sale has not been administered any exogenous anabolic steroids (“EAS”) within 45 days of the date of sale. However, in order for purchaser to take advantage of this limited warranty, Buyer must check the appropriate box on the Acknowledgment of Purchase for the horse at the time of purchase directing CTHS to take a blood sample. Buyer agrees to pay \$500 to CTHS to cover costs of the test, both direct costs and administrative expenses. CTHS will arrange for a blood sample to be taken by a veterinarian designated by CTHS prior to the horse leaving the Sales grounds, which sample shall be sent to a laboratory selected by CTHS for testing. Consignor hereby consents to a blood sample being taken. If the post-sale test reveals the presence of EAS at such level as is deemed by the testing laboratory to show that EAS have been administered to the horse within 45 days prior to sale of the horse (“Positive Test”), Buyer shall have the right to rescind the sale, which right must be exercised by Buyer giving written notice to CTHS within 24 hours of Buyer’s receipt of the results indicating a Positive Test. If Buyer elects to rescind the sale, Consignor shall refund any sales proceeds paid to Consignor by CTHS and pay buyer or CTHS all proper expenses and legal fees incurred by either of them, including interest thereon at the rate of 24% per annum, from the time of sale until the return of the horse to the Consignor. Proper expenses include, but are not limited to, the \$500 testing fee, veterinarian charges, vanning, insurance and boarding. Buyer shall be required to exercise due care during the rescission period in maintaining and boarding the horse. In the event of a Positive Test, risk of loss shall remain with Buyer from the fall

of the hammer until Consignor has been notified of Buyer's election to rescind the sale at which time risk of loss passes back to the prior owner. Buyer shall not cause the horse to be materially altered during the rescission period. CTHS will notify Consignor and Buyer of the test results as soon as is practical after receipt of the results from the testing laboratory which is anticipated to be within 14 days from date of sale. No other testing by purchaser shall be allowed to support any claim by purchaser concerning the presence of EAS. The test herein provided for shall be the sole acceptable evidence for any claims by Buyer for breach of the limited warranty provided in this FOURTEENTH CONDITION and rescission of the purchase. Neither Buyer nor Consignor shall have the right nor shall CTHS have any obligation to conduct testing of a split sample. CTHS's determination concerning whether there is a Positive Test, as long as same is supported by the testing laboratory selected by CTHS, shall be fully binding upon Consignor, Buyer and all other interested parties. If any party challenges CTHS's exercise of discretion, subject to proof of fraud or bad faith, such party shall be liable for all of CTHS's reasonable expenses, including, without limitation, its attorney's fees incurred in defending the challenge.

FIFTEENTH – AGENTS: Persons purporting to act as an agent for a Buyer must file with the Auctioneer a completed, notarized Authorization of Agent form such as appears in the sales catalogue or notarized letter of authorization from the Buyer stating that the agent is authorized to purchase at this sale for the account of the Buyer and that such Buyer agrees to be bound by all actions of the agent in connection with this sale. Any person failing to comply with this CONDITION shall be held PERSONALLY LIABLE as the Buyer.

SIXTEENTH – LIMITATION OF ACTIONS: Any cause of action arising out of or relating to this sale shall be commenced not more than one year after the date of this sale; provided, however, this limitation of action shall not apply to any action against the Buyer for recovery of the purchase price, including interest and expenses, or repossession of any horse purchased at this sale.

SEVENTEENTH – SEVERABILITY: If any provision of these CONDITIONS OF SALE is held to be illegal or invalid, such illegality or invalidity shall not affect the remaining provisions of these CONDITIONS OF SALE, and they shall be continued and enforced as if such illegal or invalid provision had never been inserted herein.

EIGHTEENTH – TIME OF ESSENCE: TIME IS OF THE ESSENCE AS TO ALL MATTERS SET FORTH IN THESE CONDITIONS OF SALE.

NINETEENTH – AGREEMENT: The entire agreement regarding the sale and purchase of a horse at this sale is contained in these Conditions of Sale and in the Acknowledgement of Purchase. Auctioneer shall not be bound by any oral or written agreement between Buyer and Consignor unless agreed to, in writing, by Auctioneer.

TWENTIETH – PAYMENT: All sales are in Canadian currency and payment (including exigible taxes) must be remitted in Canadian currency unless specific written alternative arrangements have been agreed to in advance of the sale between the purchaser and Auctioneer. All currency conversion aids (visual or otherwise) provided by Auctioneer are purely provided as a matter of courtesy and Auctioneer is not be responsible for any errors that may occur in the use of such currency conversion aids.

TWENTY-FIRST – PRIVACY: All parties agree that, by virtue of being a party to this sale, the CTHS collects personal information about you. CTHS uses such personal information collected in order to i) establish and maintain all party statuses ii) perform marketing and advertising services; and iii) meet legal obligations.

\$500,000 MARE PURCHASE PROGRAM (MPP)

The Canadian Thoroughbred Horse Society (Ontario Division) through funds provided by the Enhanced Horse Improvement Program are pleased to announce that the Mare Purchase Program will continue for foals of 2019. The program continues to assist in the expansion and improvement of the resident band of Broodmares in Ontario.

The program provides *significant financial support* to Ontario Resident Breeders investing in “New” Broodmares that will be brought into Ontario to foal in 2019 and be “Bred Back” to an Ontario Sire in 2019.

We are encouraged that the program will assist Ontario in strengthening the size and quality of our Broodmare Band. This initiative is in response to the current dilemma of a declining population of Ontario Broodmares and resulting Foals. The CTHS has continued with this program at a level of \$500,000 and are committed to support our local Breeding Industry. Further, the Program will support the Owners of Registered Ontario Stallions who have made significant contributions to Breeding in the Province by ensuring the new qualifying mares will be bred back to registered Ontario Sires.

The program for foals of 2019 offers:

Reimbursement of up to **50% of the Purchase Price** of a Pregnant Mare, bought at specific recognized public auctions. Mares must foal in Ontario in 2019 and be bred back to a registered Ontario Sire in 2019, to deliver a resulting Registered Ontario Bred, Ontario Sired Foal of 2020. The foals produced must be sold at a recognized CTHS Ontario Sale or must make 2 starts in the Province of Ontario to qualify for the Mare Program, thus supporting Commercial Breeders as well as “Breed To Race” Stakeholders.

The following is a summary of The Program Highlights:

Purchase a Mare “In-Foal” at Keeneland November, Keeneland January, OBS or Timonium in January 2019 or Fasig Kentucky in February 2019 for a minimum of \$15,000 USD and receive a reimbursement of up to 50% of the purchase price (paid in Canadian Dollars at par Value). A maximum reimbursement of up to \$15,000 (CDN) per mare purchased and a collective maximum of up to \$50,000 (CDN) per purchaser.

The Mare must foal out in Ontario and be bred back to a registered Ontario Sire in 2019. The resulting foals will either be sold at a CTHS Ontario Sale as weanlings or yearlings or make 2 starts in the Province of Ontario to qualify for the Mare Program. If said horse does not run 2x prior to his/her 4 YO year he/she can apply to the integrity committee for an exemption.
