**2021 CTHS YEARLING SALE
Request for Proposals for Veterinary Services - On Call & Identification**

The Canadian Thoroughbred Horse Society (Ontario Division) will be conducting the annual Yearling Sale on September 1st, 2021. There will be approximately 240 yearlings offered up for auction and they will be on the Sales Premises commencing August 28th.

The CTHS is going to tender for the following:

The Services of a Sale Veterinarian is required:

- 1) to provide 24 hour on call emergency services – to commence at 9:00 a.m. Saturday, August 28th through to Saturday, September 4th at 9:00 a.m.,
- 2) to provide Identification services – verifying yearling sex matches the printed catalogue i.e. colts are colts, geldings are geldings – to commence Monday, August 30th through to Wednesday, September 1st,
- 3) to draw any coggins tests as may be required,
- 4) and any other responsibilities that the CTHS deems necessary.

Qualifications: The selected Veterinarian must be licensed and experienced in the integral workings of Thoroughbred Auctions and will be responsible for all items documented above.

Terms: The successful Veterinarian will be granted a term of one (1) year with a one (1) year option to renew at the discretion of the CTHS. The Society will be invoiced for services rendered upon completion of the sale (Net 30).
